

- Meetings: 7 with Board of Directors + 1 with Stakeholders @IPAC25
  - Aiming at communication with team to be improved, and note from meetings to be made available (either on Indico or on JACoW website)
  - Coordinator activity shared with more people (1 coordinator elected to BoD and help nominated):
    - Meetings notes
    - Announcements
    - Maintenance of team member names on web
- Regular reporting from WGs will be followed up

- Completion of transition from SPMS (sunset 17<sup>th</sup> March '25) to Indico : **Thanks to Duarte, Michel, Adrian and Indico Team**

In place → JACoW conference series organised via Indico (since 2023)

**NEW** → JACoW Central Repository entirely on Indico  
(see Michel's presentation)

- Users to renew their account in Indico (mail address and not username)
- Affiliations in Research Organization Registry ([ROR](#)) (open persistent identifiers for research and funding organizations) not sufficient due to industry or not registered organizations: temporary field to be validated by Central Repository Manager.
- JACoW announcements (1 per conference) done with conference lists as last extracted from SPMS, will become dynamic (user preference in Indico profile)

**NEW** → JACoW Mailing from CERN to private (paying) provider [Brevo](#)

**NEW** → Privacy Policy with CERN legal service (still ongoing)

# JACoW

---

- IPAC: propose to have one JACoW representative (chair or director) present at IPAC series OCC meetings
- Mattermost (hosted by Helmholtz – Berlin) as channel for fast streamed communication for team members, can it be used with CiE ?

**NEW** → JACoW Proceedings publishing moved to Electra (September 2025) where NEW Proceeding Search Engine has been developed  
Thanks to Ronny for the work in the last ~ 17 y, and thanks to Ivan and Stefano for current and future work

- To be asked to KEK if backup of proceeding will continue after Oracle archivation

**NEW** → Search engine to be released (See Stefano's presentation) based on open-source Apache-SOLR

- Issue: if paper submitted with JACoW, cannot be submitted with another PR journal (see for ex. Light-Source journals), *pre-print* may be a solution for some journals

**NEW** → [www.jacow.org](http://www.jacow.org) being restyled – work in progress

- Mobile App WG – work completed, WG dissolved
  - 1. Template WG
  - 2. Documentation & Wiki WG
  - 3. IT tools WG – **NEW**
  - 4. Central Repository Manager WG – **NEW**
  - 5. Proceeding publication WG – **NEW**
  - 6. CERN hosted international collaboration set-up WG – **NEW**
- WG composition and mandate will be published on website

### 1. Template WG:

- Word and Latex templates converged on common JACoW template, should be relatively stable
- Length of paper defined by conferences
- Field to be added at registration about Latex or Word choice to help editors selection
- Agreed to issue new template versions with presentation at BoD in January and tested version release no later than March
  - Tests including on dummy conference to verify that pdf generated compliant with standard

### 2. Documentation & Wiki WG

- Information re-organised in clearer fashion + elimination of references to SPMS
- New site published ~ February 2026 for people to 'test'

### 3. IT tools WG – NEW

- Procedures to use tools to be documented
- When tools upgraded or maintained, cross-talking between tools to be included and tested

1. Central Repository Manager WG – **NEW**
  - CRMs from 3 different regions (as with SPMS)
  - Full Access to Central Repository for profile corrections or validation
  - Assisting conference during Author-Title Check (+ interact with Indico CERN?)
  - Data clean up
2. Proceeding publication WG – **NEW**
  - Write up new procedure for proceeding publication (CiE to be implicated ??)
    - DOI generated by publisher
  - Define test procedure
  - Maintain know-how
3. CERN hosted international collaboration set-up WG – **NEW**
  - Inventory of JACoW activity with associated manpower and costs
  - Chart review to include all activities and roles as bases for MoU
  - Final proposal to CERN management

- First draft presented, to be reviewed in restrained group together with CERN data privacy adviser to resolved:
  - JACoW PP to be attached to Indico and profile generation
  - Data shared with conferences held outside Europe
  - Conferences PP against JACoW PP
  - Standard amongst conferences
