

Abstract

“New Editor Perspectives: Developing a Process for Continual Improvement”

New editors who participate in Joint Accelerator Conference Website (JACoW) events bring clarity to the editorial process in conference proceedings offices, asking important questions and learning as they go. But their need for assistance can also bog down the time seasoned editors need to produce conference proceedings in a timely manner. However, JACoW is typically run by volunteers who dedicate time in addition to their regular jobs to organize details for conferences. Moreover, a selection of volunteers also move on either after their conferences or their JACoW Board terms end, recreating a persistent need for training. The goal of this presentation is to discuss the importance of new editor perspectives and provide crowd-sourced recommendations for new editors.
